
Dear friends,

Greetings from Jerusalem! As I write this we are about to begin the final day of the Gafcon conference. It has been a fantastic week of worshipping God with brothers and sisters from all over the Anglican communion representing over 70% of global Anglicanism. We have heard from God's word and thought about our shared desire: we will proclaim Christ faithfully to the nations.

The UK delegation has been made up of faithful Anglicans from England, Scotland and Wales. It has been encouraging to hear of perseverance in the face of opposition to the gospel, both from within and outside the church. Globally, we have seen the challenges of secularism but also the power of the gospel to change lives. We have been encouraged to follow God's strategy: a strategy of salvation through the proclamation of the gospel of Jesus Christ, and through a rightly ordered church where people are transformed and live new lives.

It has been encouraging to find out what is happening around the globe, and a privilege to meet with people from every continent, from a native Inuit minister to New Zealanders, via many, many people from Nigeria, Uganda and elsewhere in Africa. We all face the same challenges, to continue to share the good news of Jesus with a needy but reluctant, and sometimes hostile, world.

What are we doing this term?

Sunday Club are learning about God's big plan for his people from creation to covenant.

Fuel are looking at how to listen to a sermon, using "Listen up!" by Christopher Ash.

Sparks are venturing through the story of the Exodus and learning about how God rescues his people.

Impact and Ignition are looking at 1 Thessalonians, a letter from Paul in the New Testament to a group of newly converted Christians. This letter is full of encouragements to hold fast to Jesus in a hostile world, and advice about how to live a life pleasing to God. As you can imagine, the world that the Thessalonians were living in is pretty similar to the one our young people are growing up in!

Please do be praying for our children and young people – that those who are still deciding what they believe will see something of God's amazing love for them this term, and that those who are professing faith will be emboldened to live out their faith and enjoy knowing Jesus!
