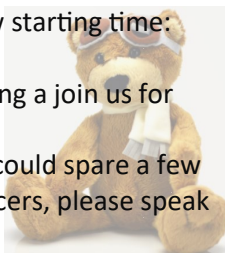

What's on this term for our under 18's?
