

### Jeremiah Kashoboorozi

Jeremiah was born in Uganda in 1955 and is married to Jaddress. They have three children, Patience, Moses and Tezra.

As a young man he attended the Church Army Training College at Mbale Uganda, where our church contributed to his support through our 10<sup>th</sup> Sunday Project. When he finished training as top student in his final year we continued with support through the project until the Church Army moved all the staff to their college in Nairobi, Kenya. During this time the CA sent him twice to England for treatment to neck pains and also to represent CA Africa at a World CA Conference. He met the Queen Mother at Clarence House and came to Duffield at the invitation of John & Kathleen Weller when he stayed with Derek & me.

He was a tutor at the Nairobi college until it fell into difficulties: the Principal resigned and Jeremiah became Acting Principal working on a new syllabus. This all came to an end when a new English Principal was appointed in 1993 and Jeremiah and family travelled back to Mbarara, Uganda partly funded by our congregation. Temporary jobs and illnesses have made life very difficult for them since but latterly Jeremiah has become Chaplain to two prisons in Mbarara and is preparing 80 prisoners for Confirmation. He has been suffering high blood pressure for a while now and recently spent 40 days in hospital following a stroke. He is recovering and would like us to pray for him.
