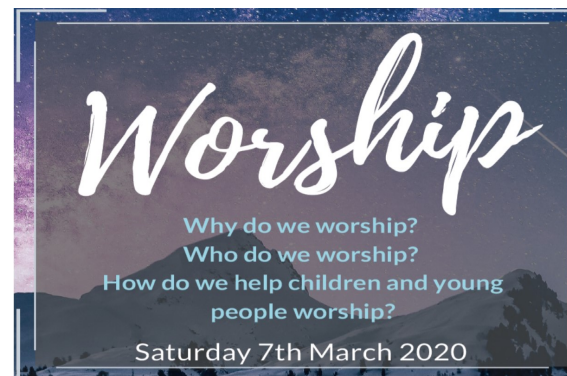
A day for Council and Church members from churches
